This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from unnamed stream to be appropriated under application No. 55930, permit No. 41929 ; being 0.1 a.f. for stock, and 0.9 a.f. for irrigation

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.0 acre feet.

The priority date of this permit is May 17, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 12, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979.
