1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Armitage Reservoir.

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is winter runoff in Unnamed Gulch. tributary of Little Butte Creek.

3. The amount of water to be stored is 8.0 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is recreation - see remarks. (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 8 (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

Tp. 36 S., R. 1 E., W.M. The maximum height will be 8.5 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 95 feet; length on bottom 60 feet; width on top 14 feet; slope on front or water side 3 to 1; slope on back 2 to 1; height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet. (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: clay; no wave protection needed.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 2.0 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 6.0 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 4.0 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$5,000.00.

12. Construction work will begin on or before October 1, 1973.

13. Construction work will be completed on or before October 1, 1974.
