

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Peyton Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Springs, tributary to Ora Creek,
tributary of Rogue River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 8.75 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation and fish pond
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 20, T. 33 S., R. 2 E.W.M.
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)

6. The dam will be located in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 20,
(Smallest legal subdivision)
Tp. 33 S, R. 2 E, W. M. It will be 9.5 feet in height,

having a length on top of 300 feet; length on bottom 200 feet; width on top 15 feet slope of front or water side 1 to 1 1/2 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical) slope on back 1 to 1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full one foot feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Rock and dirt fill with willows planted on water side, blackberries on lower side.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Around dam, (State whether over or around the dam) protected by lumber lining.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: Same location as wasteway, 2 feet wide by 1.5 feet, lumber box. (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 2.5 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 7.0 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 3.5 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 1,500.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before Under construction

13. Construction work will be completed on or before 1 year
