

# Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Fred Cyphers (Name of Applicant)

of RFD, The Dalles, County of Wasco

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation none

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Hazeldell Orchards

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Three Mile or Holman Creek

tributary of Columbia River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 2 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation  
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 12, Township 1 North, Range 13 East, W.M.  
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet not to be located in channel or stream

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions water appropriated thru ditch, dimensions 2 feet wide and 1 foot deep, the ditch is approximately 500 feet in length.

6. The dam will be located in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 12,  
(Smallest legal subdivision)  
Tp. 1 N, R. 13 E, W. M. It will be 4 feet in height,

having a length on top of 12 feet; length on bottom 5 feet; width on top 4 feet slope of front or water side (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical) slope on back (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full 2 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: the dam is constructed of sod and sacks of soil. It is removed every winter and is only temporary in nature.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: (State whether over or around the dam)

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 1/4 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 5 feet; and approximate mean depth of water feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 500.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before construction work began 15 years ago.

13. Construction work will be completed on or before will be entirely completed in 1936.
