

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, U. S. Department of Agriculture, Forest Service (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Dale R. S. Water Development

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Meadow Brook

tributary of North Fork John Day River

3. The amount of water to be stored is approximately 1/4 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation and domestic use (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 2, Township 7 S., Range 31 East, W.M. (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Situated in channel of running stream, material at outlet is gravel and small boulders.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Sec. 2, (Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 7 S., R. 31 E., W. M. It will be Five feet in height, (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

having a length on top of 50 feet; length on bottom 50 feet; width on top 18 feet slope of front or water side 1/4 : 1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Dam to be built of concrete

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Wasteway over dam (State whether over or around the dam)

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 3" pipe line through dam. (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be approximately 1/7 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 3 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 1 1/2 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 2500.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before May 10, 1936

13. Construction work will be completed on or before June 30, 1936
