

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, James Thomas Leonard (Name of Applicant)

of Anchor, County of Douglas (Postoffice)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Maple Creek Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Maple Creek

tributary of Cow Creek

3. The amount of water to be stored is 1 1/2 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 32, Tp. 31 S., R. 3 W.W.M. (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet situated in channel of running stream - clay soil at outlet

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 32 (Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 31 S, R. 3 W, W. M. It will be 9 1/2 feet in height, (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

having a length on top of 70 feet; length on bottom 49 feet; width on top 13 1/2 feet slope of front or water side vertical (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical) slope on back vertical (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full 1 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Concrete 1 ft. wide across bottom from bed rock to stream level. 2 1/2 ft. thru timbers for back logs, 1 ft. thru timbers for front side with 10 ft. of clay between

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: (State whether over or around the dam) Wasteway over center of dam. 5 ft. wide 1 ft. high

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: Outlet thru dam. 8 in. concrete pipe (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 1500 sq. ft. acres, with a maximum depth of water of 8 1/2 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 4 1/4 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 200.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before Sept. 1, 1936

13. Construction work will be completed on or before Dec. 1, 1936
