

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Lloyd Gift (Name of applicant)

of Bonanza (Post office), County of Klamath

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is The Lloyd Gift Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is an unnamed watercourse (run-off only)

tributary of Barnes Creek

3. The amount of water to be stored is 411 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation and stock (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. s 33 and 34, T. 38 S., R. 15 E., W.M., (Give sections or townships to be submerged) and sections 3 and 4 of Twp. 39 S., R. 15 E., W. M.

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet an unnamed channel carrying only Spring run off water flows through the reservoir site.

6. The dam will be located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Sec. 4 & the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 3 (Smallest legal subdivision) Tp. 39 S. (No. N. or S.), R. 15 E. (No. E. or W.), W. M. It will be 11.5 feet in height,

having a length on top of 385 feet; length on bottom 150
 feet; width on top 8 feet slope of front or water side 2-1

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: earth with a stone rip-rap on upstream side

Barnes Creek for irrigation and stock purposes under Permit No. 12649.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 411 acre feet.

The priority date of this permit is February 22, 1937.
