The length on top will be 250 feet; length on bottom 250 feet; width on top 10 feet; slope on front or water side 3; slope on back 2; height of dam above water line when full 3 feet.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be One acres, with a maximum depth of water of 3 feet, and approximate mean depth of water 1 feet.


