

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

X We, the Glasgow Co-operative Water Association (Name of applicant)

of North Bend (Post office), County of Coos

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Unnamed

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Unnamed tributary of Coos Bay, Oregon

3. The amount of water to be stored is 0.10 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Domestic (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 2, Tp. 25 S., R. 13 W., W. M. (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet In channel of small creek, material, about three feet of soil overburden above shale rock.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in NE 1/4 NE 1/4 (Smallest legal subdivision), Sec. 2, Tp. 25 South (No. N. or S.), R. 13 West (No. E. or W.), W. M. It will be 9 feet in height,

having a length on top of 34 feet; length on bottom 13 feet; width on top 0.6 to 1 feet slope of front or water side (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)
 slope on back none; height of dam above water line when full 1 feet. Timber dam, no earth fill

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Plank face supported by log backing. Reservoir too small for waves to form. Located in bottom of gulch.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: 1' by 3' plank wasteway over top of dam. (State whether over or around the dam)

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 6" wood pipe through face of dam (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 0.04 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 8 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 2.5 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 100.00
