Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, We, W. A. Woodard Lumber Company, a corporation (Name of applicant)

of Cottage Grove (Post office), County of Lane State of Oregon

do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation Cottage Grove, Oregon, August 14, 1925

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is W. A. Woodard Lumber Company Log Pond

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Coast Fork of Willamette tributary of Willamette River

3. The amount of water to be stored is Seventy-eight (78) acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is For log pond (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. W 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 5, Twp. 21 S., R. 3 W., W. M. Lane County, Oregon. (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Pond will be constructed outside river. River channel to be moved as indicated on plat.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions Will be filled by condenser discharge from W. A. Woodard Lumber Company's sawmill steam plant as indicated on accompanying plat.

6. The dam will be located in W 1/2 SE 1/4 (Smallest legal subdivision), Sec. 5, Tp. 21 S., R. 3 W., W. M. It will be Five and one-half (5 1/2) feet in height, (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

Remarks: This project is entirely embraced by land owned by
W. A. Woodard Lumber Company.
A part of the water described in Application No. 18788, Permit
No. 14430, passes through condensers and is used to supply the
log pond described in this application.
