

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

SUPERSEDED CERTIFICATE NO. 45386

I, Archie C. Loud, of Elkton, County of Douglas, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Golden Creek tributary of Umpqua River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 20,000 gallons 0.06 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation and domestic (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 9, T. 22 S., R. 9 W. (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet In Channel of Golden Creek Dirt, Rock, Gravel

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in Lot 1, Sec. 9, Tp. 22 S., R. 9 W., W. M. It will be 6 feet in height, (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

having a length on top of 34 feet; length on bottom 34 feet; width on top 9" feet slope of front or water side vertical (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)
 slope on back straight filled in with rock/ against dam. (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)
6 " feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: concrete with steel reinforcing

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: over dam (State whether over or around the dam)
Spillway 6" deep by 12 ft. wide. Wood construction. Dam to be concrete with steel reinforcing 9" thick.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: center 2" pipe through the dam about 2' from bottom of dam wall. (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 2800 sq. ft. acres, with a maximum depth of water of 6' feet; and approximate mean depth of water 4' feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 600.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before Sep't. 15, 1940

13. Construction work will be completed on or before April 1, 1941
