

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Coastal Lumber Co. (Name of applicant) of Grand Ronde, Oregon (Post office), County of Polk, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation July 7, 1941; Portland, Oregon

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Coastal Lumber Co. log pond

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Rogue River tributary of South Yamhill River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 10 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Mill log pond (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 12, Township 6 South, 8 West (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Not located in channel of running stream.

Only outlet is 4" steel pipe to hydrant. Materials, red clay.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions Pond to be filled by 4" Myers Centrifugal Pump.

6. The Pond will be located in SW 1/4 of SW 1/4, Sec. 12, Dikes (Smallest legal subdivision), Tp. 6 South, R. 8 West, W. M. It will be 5 to 7 feet in height, (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

 7. The construction of ~~dam~~, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Dikes to be constructed of compacted red clay. Constructed with a 2 to 1 slope on water side. Pond to be continuously full of logs to prevent wave action.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Only wasteway to be 4" steel pipe to hydrant.  
 (State whether over or around the dam)

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: Only outlet is 4" steel pipe to hydrant.  
 (State whether through or around the proposed dam)
