State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the Oxford reservoir

and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled is Oxford Creek
tributary to Day Creek

2. If not in channel of a stream, state how it is to be filled.

3. The dam will be located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13,
Township 26 S, Range 14 W, W. M.

4. The maximum height will be 8 feet above stream bed or ground surface at the
centerline. The top width will be 10 ft feet, slope of upstream face gradual,
slope of downstream face approx 35°, and height of dam above water line when full
2 feet.

5. The dam will be (check one) earthfill, concrete, flashboard, other.

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
