

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Dillard Lumber Co. (Name of applicant)

of Roseburg, County of Douglas (Post office)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is No name This is for log pond

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is South Umpqua River tributary of The Umpqua River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 285 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Log Storage (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 33, T. 28 S., R. 6 W. W.M. (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet not in stream channel

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions 10 inch steel pipe line

6. The dam will be located in S 1/2 of the NW 1/4 & the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4, Sec. 33, Tp. 28 S., R. 6 W., W. M. It will be from 11 to 15 feet in height, (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

having a length on top of 4000 feet; length on bottom 4000 feet; width on top 18 feet slope of front or water side 3 to 1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical) slope on back 2 to 1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full 3 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: three foot freeboard for wind protection, (waves) Dike will be earth construction

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: at low end of pond (State whether over or around the dam) near N. W. corner of pond. Size of pipe 24 inch dia. under dam.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: location same as wasteway and 24 inch conc. pipe. (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 40.7 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 12 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 7 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 10,000.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before 7-1-1944

13. Construction work will be completed on or before 5-15-1945
