PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-61130 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Ray Tarter of 14740 Airlie Road, Monmouth, Oregon 97361, phone 838-6233, for the construction of the Tarter Reservoir and storage of water from intermittent seepage to be appropriated under Application 61131, Permit 46258, for irrigation.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 32, Township 9 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

The maximum height will be 8.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 14.0 feet, alope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 4:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.6 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 15.0 feet.

The location of the spillway is: Over dam (Cement bottom and sides).

The location and dimension of the outlet or bypass, and control works are: 24-inch outlet pipe with a 4.0 feet by 4.0 feet box inlet through the center of the dam.

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 4.0 acre-feet.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is December 14, 1981.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 9, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.
