PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-59190 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Vance Means of 2275 Webster Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 479-4022, for the enlargement of the reservoir constructed under Permit R-5290 and storage of water from an unnamed drainageway to be appropriated under Application 61643, Permit 46461, for beautification.

The reservoir will be LOCATED in the: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 24, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

There is no dam, the storage area is excavated.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 10.0 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 10.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet or bypass, and control works are: 18-inch corrugated steel pipe located at most Southerly point.

The structure is out of the channel.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 11.0 acre-feet.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is April 20, 1981.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 29, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.
