PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-61108 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Williams Land Company of Route 1, Box 834, Bonanza, Oregon 97623, phone 545-6572, for the construction of the Vinson Spring Reservoir and storage of water from Vinson Spring for stock water.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 18, Township 38 South, Range 13 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

There is no dam, the storage area is excavated.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.05 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 1.0 foot.

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: none.

The location and dimension of the outlet or bypass, and control works are: none.

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be an excavation pond.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.05 acre-foot.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is December 31, 1980.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 29, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.
