PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-63035 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Hollis Gunter of 376 Bonnie Lane, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 479-8646, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from Louse Creek to be appropriated under Application 63209, Permit 46665, for recreation.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

The maximum height will be 4.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 15.0 feet, slope of upstream face 4:1, slope of downstream face 5:1, and height of dam above water line when full 1.5 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.0 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 5.0 feet.

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: Bottom width 8.0 feet, top width 8.0 feet, depth 1.5 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet or bypass, and control works are: At South end of dam, cement spillway 8.0 feet wide and 18 inches deep.

The structure is out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 4.0 acre-feet.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is November 9, 1981.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.
