PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-62825 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to DeWayne F. Boling of Route 3, Box 5000, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 679-7718, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed intermittent stream to be appropriated under Application 63591, Permit 46698, for irrigation and stock water.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 36, Township 27 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.1 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 10.0 feet.

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: No spillway. Any excess will run around pond on natural ground.

The location and dimension of the outlet or bypass, and control works are: 12-inch concrete pipe.

The structure is in the channel.

There is no dam. The pond is excavated.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.0 acre-foot, being 0.5 acre-foot for irrigation and 0.5 acre-foot for stock water.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 22, 1981.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.
