PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-62341 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Randolph and Phyllis K. Bass of Route 4, Box 138-D, Cornelius, Oregon 97113, phone 648-4080, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream to be appropriated under Application 62342, Permit 46701, for irrigation.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 1 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

The maximum height will be 8.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.5 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 6.0 feet.

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: Around dam. Bottom width 10.0 feet, top width 20.0 feet, depth 2.5 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet or bypass, and control works are: 12-inch culvert through embankment.

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 2.0 acre-feet.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is August 17, 1981.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.
