PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-62653 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to United States, Wallowa-Whitman National Forest of Route 1, Box 83, Joseph, Oregon 97846, phone 432-2171, for the construction of the C-5 Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed intermittent stream for stock water.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 3, Township 2 North, Range 45 East, WM, in the County of Wallows.

The maximum height will be 6.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 4.0 feet, slope of upstream face 2:1, slope of downstream face 1:1, and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.05 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 3.0 feet.

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: Around dam. The bottom width will be 5.0 feet. The top width will be 8.0 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 3.0 feet.

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.11 acre-foot.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 11, 1981.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.
