PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-63588 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Steven Walter Johnson of PO Box 162, Beaver Creek, Oregon 97004, phone 632-6228, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from Beaver Creek to be appropriated under Application 63589, Permit 46758 for irrigation, stock water and recreation.

The reservoir will be LOCATED in the: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 3 South, Range 2 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

The area submerced by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.06 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 6.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet or bypass, and control works are: None to be constructed; excess water will flow out through existing stream channel.

The structure is in the channel.

The reservoir will be an excavated pond.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.2 acre-foot, being 0.1 acre-foot for recreation, 0.09 acre-foot for irrigation and 0.01 acre-foot for stock water.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is May 28, 1982.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 13, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.
