## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-63212 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Larry W. and Shirley J. Gunter of 24850 SE Highway 212, Boring, Oregon 97009, phone 658-6618, for the construction of the Lake Michigan Reservoir and storage of water from Noyer Creek to be appropriated under Application 63213, Permit 46848, for irrigation and recreation.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 2 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Clackemas.

The maximum height will be 4.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The width will be 12.0 feet and height of dam above water line when full 4.0 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.15 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 18.0 feet.

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: Over top of flashboards; width 12.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet or bypass, and control works are: Three 4-inch PVC pipes under dam.

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be concrete construction with removable boards.

All flashboards are to be removed from spillway during the period from October I to April I of each year.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.5 acre-feet, being 0.5 acre-foot for irrigation and 1.0 acre-foot for recreation.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is January 13, 1982.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 17, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.
