PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-58141 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Sidney T. and Pauline A. Gobel of Route 1, Box 32, Banks, Oregon 97106, phone 324-7252, for the construction of an unnamed reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream with any deficiency in the available supply from the unnamed stream to be made up by diversion from Bledsoe Creek to be appropriated under Application 58142, Permit 46940, for wildlife attraction. The right allowed herein for storage for wildlife attraction shall be subordinate and inferior to all future rights for storage for beneficial consumptive use.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 1 North, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

The maximum height will be 5.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 12.3 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 1.0 foot.

The structure is out of the channel of the unnamed stream.

The dam will be flashboard construction.

All flashboards are to be removed from the spillway during the period from February 1 to September 30 of each year.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 7.4 acre-feet.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is December 4, 1978.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 29, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.
