

### Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Ralph W. Badcock (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Barnes & Badcock

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Seepage, runoff and waste water from Williams & Whalen ditch also springs within storage reservoir. tributary of

3. The amount of water to be stored is  $\frac{1}{4}$  acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 10 NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Tp. 35 S, R. 14 W, W. M., in the county of Jackson (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet not in channel of stream, pond excavated

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions Waste, seepage, & runoff waters from Williams and Whalen ditch also springs within reservoirs.  $1\frac{1}{2}$  feet feeder ditch.
