PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-63446 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to John E. Schlegel of Route 1, Box 160-G, Harrison Road, Banks, Oregon 97106, phone 324-4533, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from Bledsoe Creek to be appropriated under Application 63447, Permit 46979, for irrigation.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 2 North, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

The maximum height will be 9.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 18.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.0 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.13 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 8.0 feet.

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: a by-pass channel dug around reservoir. The bottom width will be 2.0 feet. The top width will be 10.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet or bypass, and control works are: Steel culvert at bottom of reservoir 36 inches by 40 feet.

The structure is in the channel.

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The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.6 acre-foot.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is April 2, 1982.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 7, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.
