PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-64055 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Donald W. Neal of 1410 SW Morrison Street #804, Portland, Oregon 97205, phone 246-1972, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from the Tualatin River to be appropriated under Application 64051, Permit 47067, for wildlife attraction.

The reservoir will be LOCATED in the: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 2 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 3.5 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 3.0 feet.

The structure is out of the channel and is a natural depression.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 7.0 acre-feet.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 1, 1982.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 3, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.
