### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-34856 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Rene L. Bounds of Emigrant Road, Ashland, Oregon 97502, for the construction of the Bounds Reservoir and storage of water from Emigrant Creek for recreation, and is subject to the terms and conditions of a stipulation recorded at pages 781-784, Volume 6, Miscellaneous Records of the Water Resources Director, and by reference made a part of this permit, and the dam shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered professional engineer.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20, Township 39 South, Range 2 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

The maximum height will be 26.0 feet above the streambed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 14.0 feet, slope of upstream face 2.5:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 7.0 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 11.0 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 16.5 feet.

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: Around right abutment - 42-foot width.

The dimension of the outlet or bypass, and control works are: 12-inch corrugated metal pipe.

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 92.9 acre-feet.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is August 15, 1961.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 14, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.
