PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **R-64599** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to **James Pierce Petitti of 17610 Shady Lane, Monmouth, Oregon 97361, phone 838-6405**, for the construction of **Petitti Reservoir** and storage of water from an unnamed **drainageway** with any deficiency in the supply of water available from the drainageway to be made up by diversion from three springs, to be appropriated under Application 64600, Permit 47321, for irrigation and fish culture.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: **NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 9 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.**

The maximum height will be **9.75** feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be **8.0 feet**, slope of upstream face **3:1**, slope of downstream face **2:1**, and height of dam above water line when full **2.0 feet**.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be **1.2 acres**, and the maximum depth of water will be **7.75 feet**.

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit are: **12-inch concrete sewer pipe (bell and spigot) 65 feet long.**

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of **5.7 acre-feet, being 2.7 acre-feet for irrigation and 3.0 acre-feet for fish culture.**

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is **December 28, 1982.**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **March 14, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 19 85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 19 86**.
