PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-64419 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Robert G. McKenzie, Jr., PO Box 187, Port Orford, Oregon, 97465, phone 332-3384, for the construction of sump Reservoirs A and C and storage of water from an two unnamed streams, tributary of Floras Lake, to be appropriated under Application 64420, Permit 47420 for irrigation, temperature control and flood harvesting of cranberries.

The dam will be LOCATED in the Reservoir A - NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 32; Reservoir C - SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 29, both within Township 31 South, Range 15 West, WM; in the County of Curry

The maximum height will be n/a feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be n/a, slope of upstream face n/a, slope of downstream face 1:1, and height of dam above water line when full +2 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be * , and the maximum depth of water will be

- * Reservoir A - 1.18 acre, Reservoir C - 1.69 acre
- ** 3.0 af from Unnamed Stream 2 and 16.0 af in Reservoir C, being 12.25 af from Unnamed Stream 1 and 3.75 af from Unnamed Stream 2.

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: None.

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The structures are out of the channel; the reservoirs are excavated.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 27.0 acre-feet, being 27.0 af for each use not to exceed 27.0 af, being 11.0 af in Reservoir A, being 8.0 af from Unnamed Stream 1 and **
The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is October 7, 1982

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 29, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .
Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
