PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-64554 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Steve Illingworth of 1340 Crooks Creek Road, Selma, Oregon 97538, phone 597-2635, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from two springs, tributary of Crooks Creek, to be appropriated under Application 64555, Permit 47432 for wildlife conservation.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 4, Township 38 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

The maximum height will be 3.5 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 4 feet, slope of upstream face n/a, slope of downstream face n/a, and height of dam above water line when full 1 foot.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.2 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 8 feet.

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: None.

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: 2-inch plastic pipe (pond is fed by 3/4-inch pipe).

The structure is out of the channel.

The dam will be hole dug in the ground, 3 1/2-foot earth perimeter, total depth 8 feet, 3 1/2-foot dam, 4 1/2 feet below ground surface.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.1 acre-foot, being 0.05 af from each spring.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is November 26, 1982.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 n/a.
