PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-64591 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Betty M. Hayes of Route I, Box 9, Logsden, Oregon 97357, phone 444-2266, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream, tributary of Siletz River, to be appropriated under Application 64592, Permit 47438 for domestic use for one family, irrigation and stock water.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 29, Township 9 South, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Lincoln.

The maximum height will be $\frac{8}{\text{be 8 feet}}$, slope of upstream face $\frac{8}{\text{full 2 feet}}$, slope of downstream face $\frac{2}{\text{sil}}$, and height of dam above water line when

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.5 acre , and the maximum depth of water will be 8 feet.

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: bottom width 8.0 feet, top width 10.0 feet, distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 2.5 feet.

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: 24-inch metal pipe through the bottom of the fill, it is equipped with a control gate.

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of domestic use and 0.25 af for stock water.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is December 22, 1982.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before $\frac{May}{11}$, $\frac{1984}{1984}$, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 $\frac{85}{11}$. Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 $\frac{n}{a}$.
