## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-64612 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Specialtrees Nursery Company of Route 2, Box 214A, Dayton, Oregon 97114, phone 868-7831, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from Paimer Creek, tributary of Willamette River, to be appropriated under Application 64613, Permit 47497 for nursery operations which include use on containerized stock and in greenhouses

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 7, Township 5 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

The maximum height will be 6.5 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 12 feet , slope of upstream face 2:1 , slope of downstream face 31 , and height of dam above water line when full 2 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 3.8 acres , and the maximum depth of water will be 8 feet.

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: None.

The location and dimensions of the outlet condults will be: None.

The structure is out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 28.0 acre-feet.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is January 4, 1983.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 13, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85. Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 n/a
