This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **R-64775** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to **James W. Smith of 2005 Murphy Creek Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 862-2486, is limited to the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream and Murphy Creek, tributary Applegate River, with any deficiency in the available supply from the unnamed stream to be made up by appropriation from Murphy Creek to be appropriated under Application 64776, Permit 47522 for fish culture.**

The dam will be LOCATED in the: **NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 38 South, Range 6 West, WM.**

The maximum height will be **n/a** feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be **n/a**, slope of upstream face **n/a**, slope of downstream face **n/a**, and height of dam above water line when full **n/a**

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be **0.03 acre**, and the maximum depth of water will be **12.0 feet**

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: **None**

The locations and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: **2-inch black pipe**

The structure is out of the channel

The reservoir is an excavation **60 feet by 30 feet by 12 feet deep.**

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of **0.36 acre-foot**

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is **January 21, 1983**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **July 15, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **n/a**.
