This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-61610 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Thomas Orchards, Incorporated and Jack Cavender of Box 348, Kimberly, Oregon 97848, phone 934-2870, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from Intermittent stream (Pine Hollow Creek) with any deficiency in the supply of water available from the intermittent stream to be made up by diversion from North Fork John Day River, to be appropriated under Application 65014, Permit 47562 for Irrigation

The dam will be LOCATED in the: N 1/2 NE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 9 South, Range 27 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

The maximum height will be 32.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 15 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2.5:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 15.0 acres , and the maximum depth of water will be 26.5 feet.

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: Around the west end of the dam. Bottom width 16 feet, top width 19.6 feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 2.5 feet.

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: 12 inch conduit at ground level, through center of dam as shown on Sheet I of plans.

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction. The dam shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered professional engineer.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 175.0 acre-feet.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is May 9, 1983

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 27, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 85. Extended to October 1987.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19, n/a.
