PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **R-63771** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to **Richard Vetsch of Route 1, Box 378, Portland, Oregon 97231, phone 621-3458,** for the construction of **Vetsch Reservoir** and storage of animal liquid waste to be appropriated under Application 64326, Permit 47539 for supplemental irrigation

The dam will be LOCATED in the: **NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 3, Township 2 North, Range 1 West, WM,** in the County of Multnomah.

The maximum height will be **6.0** feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be **8 feet**, slope of upstream face **3:1**, slope of downstream face **2:1**, and height of dam above water line when full **2.2 feet**

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be **0.29 acre**, and the maximum depth of water will be **7.8 feet.**

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: **N/A**

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: **none**

The structure is out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction with excavated pond.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of **1.63 acre-feet.**

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is **July 27, 1982**.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **July 15, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **n/a**.
