CONSTRUCT A RESERVOIR AND TO STORE FOR BENEFICIAL USE

## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-65181 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Robert P. Mobley of 25227 Taylor Park Road, SE, Lyons, Oregon 97358, phone 859-2758, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed creek, a tributary to Little North Fork North Santiam River for fish culture.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 9 South, Range 2 East, WM, in the County of Marion.

The maximum height will be 6.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 7 feet , slope of upstream face 2:1 , slope of downstream face 4:1 , and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.38 acre , and the maximum depth of water will be 10.0 feet.

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: n/a

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: Hooded inlet 8-inch corrugated pipe with antiseep collar. Inlet located 2.5 feet below crest of bank. Returns water to unnamed creek.

The structure is out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 2.0 acre-feet.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is June 8, 1983

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 29, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 n/s.
