## PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-64951 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Arnold H. and Marian T. Anderson of PO Box 553, Cave Junction, Oregon 97523, phone 592-3782, for the construction of two reservoirs and the storage of water from an unnamed stream and springs with any deficiency in the available supply to be made up by diversion from the West Fork Illinois River, a tributary of West Fork Illinois River, to be appropriated under Application 64952, Permit 47599 for recreation,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 32, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

The maximum height will be 0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be O , slope of upstream face 0 , slope of downstream face 0 , and height of dam above water line when full

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be , and the maximum depth of water will be Pond 1 -12.0 feet and Pond 2 - 7.0 feet

- Pond I 0.04 acre and Pond 2 0.20 acre
- \*\* Fork Illinois River) and 1.0 af in Reservoir 2 (0.5 af from creek and 0.50 af from spring with any deficiency to be made up by diversion from West Fork Illinois River.
