PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-64548 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to John Jacobson of 7130 Smullen Road, Mt. Hood, Oregon 97041, phone 352-7492, for the construction of 4 reservoirs and storage of water from Yellow Jacket Creek and an unnamed stream, to be appropriated under Application 63760, Permit 47448, tributary of the East Fork of Hood River, for irrigation

The dam will be LOCATED in the: Reservoir $1 - NE1/4 \ NW1/4$ of Section 9, Township 1 South, Range 10 East, WM; Reservoir $2 - SW1/4 \ SE1/4$ of Section 4, T1S, R10E, WM; Reservoir $3 - NW1/4 \ SE1/4$ of Section 4, T1S, R10E, WM; Reservoir $4 - NE1/4 \ SE1/4$ of Section 4, T1S,* The maximum height will be 9.9 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 8 feet slope of upstream face 3:1 slope of downstream face 2:1 and height of dam above water line when full 3 feet.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.5~acres , and the maximum depth of water will be 1.5~feet.

- * RIOE, WM; all within the County of Hood River.
- ** of Reservoirs 2, 3 and 4.

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: Around north side of dam, bottom width 12 feet, top width 24 feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 3 feet.

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The structures are out of the channel.

The dams will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 36.0 acre-feet, being 9.0 af from Yellow Jacket Creek stored in Reservoir 1 and 27.0 af from an unnamed stream being 9.0 af stored in each ** The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is November 22, 1982.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 31, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 . Extended to October 1987

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 n/a.
