**PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE
for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS**

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-65822 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to George and Susan Potter of HC52-Box 397, Coos Bay, Oregon 97420, phone 267-2789, for the construction of unnamed (Hummingbird Hill) Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream to be appropriated under Application 65568, Permit 47646 for domestic use for two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden for each.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 25 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

The maximum height will be 6.6 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 4.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.1 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 4.0 feet.

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: Over the dam, bottom width 1.6 feet, top width 2.6 feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 2.6 feet. The spillway is to be lined with four inches of concrete.

The location and dimensions of the outlet conduit will be: Concrete conduit, 12 inches in diameter, through base of dam 2 inches above ground on floor of reservoir.

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.037 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 1, 1983 .

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 20, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985 .
