PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-60889 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to City of Phoenix, City Hall, 510 West First Street, Phoenix, Oregon 97535, phone 535-1955, for storage of water in Lost Creek Reservoir which was constructed by the U.S. Army, Corps of Engineers under Public Law 87-874 as a part of the Rogue River Project and which was constructed under Permit R-8142. The City has contracted for storage capacity to provide for the needs for municipal water supplies to be appropriated under *

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of W 1/2 SW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 33 South, Range 1 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

The maximum height will be 345 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 24.0 feet, slope of upstream face 1.75:1, slope of downstream face 1.85:1, and height of dam above water line when full 10 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 3430.0 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 322.0 feet

The right granted herein is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract DACW 57-52-H-0003 between the United States of America, through the U.S. Army, Corps of Engineers, and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director,

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: None.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: Multiple use 271 feet high intake tower with 33 feet via well well an 25 feet via dry well located on right abutment outflow through 12 - 8x5 intake parts with gates.

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 400.0 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is October 9, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 11, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.
