PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-63956 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Larry F. Hyatt of PO Box 5016, Charleston, Oregon 97420, phone 888-9188, for the construction of 3 reservoirs and storage of water from Big Creek to be appropriated under Application 63957, Permit 47712 for irrigation.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, Township 26 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

The maximum height will be 2:3 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 3:5 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.6 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 3.0 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 19.0 feet

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: Bottom width 7.0+ feet, top width 3.0+ feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 2.6 feet

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The structure is out of the channel.

The impoundment structure will be earthfill construction. Excavated Impoundment Area creating a sunken lake with earth berm and riprap overflow to open ditch at lower end.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 19.6 acre-feet, being 9.1 acre-feet in Reservoir 1, 7.0 acre-feet in Reservoir 2, 3.5 acre-feet in Reservoir 3
The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is August 27, 1982

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.
