PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-65015 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to George A. Walker, George R. Walker and Lula Fay Walker of Route 1, Box 1566, La Grande, Oregon 97850, phone 963-5667, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from Smith Creek to be appropriated under Application 65173, Permit 47732 for supplemental irrigation and fish culture.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 33, Township 1 South, Range 38 East, WM, in the County of Union.

The maximum height will be 8.5 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 7.0 feet, slope of upstream face 1.3:1, slope of downstream face 1.8:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.0557 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 6.0 feet

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: This reservoir is a pond which was formed by excavating a hole with a dozer and forming a dike around the perimeter of the pond. The overflow of the pond is four-inch orangeburg piping.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: On north side of pond 20 feet from inside of dam face, down 2.5 feet from top of pond bank, outlet orangeburg pipe 4" x 8.5' with no restriction, same side additional drain pipe, iron, with gatevalve 2" x 10' — 2 feet from pond bottom, pond dug in pasture and not in stream bed or channel. Outlet water falls into man-made irrigation ditch, used for irrigation of garden and cow pastures below pond.

The structure is out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.33 acre-foot, being 0.20 af for irrigation and 0.13 af for fish culture.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is April 11, 1983.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.
