## PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-63054 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to City of McMinnville of 130 North Baker Street, McMinville, Oregon 97128, phone 472-6158, for the enlargement of Haskins (Walter Link) Reservoir, tributary North Yamhill River and storage of water from Haskins Creek to be appropriated under Application 63117, Permit 47779 for municipal use and the dam shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered professional engineer,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 3 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

The maximum height will be 79.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 15.0 feet , slope of downstream face 1.51 , and height of dam above water line when full 5.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 23.0 acres , and the maximum depth of water will be 72.5 feet

\* 3:1, 2.5:1

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 5.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: The outlet conduit is located at the bottom of the maximum section. It is a 5.0 foot diameter poured in place, reinforced concrete conduit gated at the upstream end with a 72-inch circular sluice gate.

The structure is in the channel.

The dam will be earth and rockfill with graded filters separating the two.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 355.0 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is November 23, 1981 -

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 17, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985 .
