PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **R-65269** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to **Dave H. Brooks, dba Brookhill Farms of Oregon, Route 1, Box 906, Bandon, Oregon 97411, phone 347-9296**, for the construction of Reservoirs 2, 6 and 7, and storage of water from Crooked Creek to be appropriated under Application 66058, Permit 47906 for temperature control,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: **Pond 2 - NE 1/4 NW 1/4; Pond 6 - NE 1/4 NE 1/4; Pond 7 - NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 18, Township 29 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Coos.**

The maximum height will be _____ feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be _____, slope of upstream face _____, slope of downstream face _____, and height of dam above water line when full

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be **1.11 acres**, and the maximum depth of water will be *

* **Pond 2 - 10 feet, Pond 6 - 12.5 feet and Pond 7 - 10.0 feet**

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: **None.**

The locations and dimensions of the outlet conduits will be: **Pond 2 - 6 inch PVC pipe and 8 inch PVC pipe; Pond 6 - none; Pond 7 - 6 inches by 8 inches oblong wood outlet.**

The structures are out of the channel.

The reservoirs will be off channel, dug out, flush with ground level.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of **1.6 acre-feet in Reservoir 2; 1.5 acre-feet in Reservoir 6 and 1.0 acre-foot in Reservoir 7**

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is **July 5, 1983**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 2, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19**85**.
