PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **R-65272** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to **Philip W. Snyder, 19993 S. South End Road, Oregon City, Oregon 97045, phone 656-7075,** for the construction of a reservoir, and storage of water from an unnamed intermittent stream, a tributary of Willamette River for stock water,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: **SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.**

The maximum height will be **9.9** feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be **12.0 feet**, slope of upstream face **3:1**, slope of downstream face **3:1**, and height of dam above water line when full **2.5 feet**

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be **0.5 acre**, and the maximum depth of water will be **7.4 feet**

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: **Bottom width 16.0 feet, top width 24.0 feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 2.5 feet.**

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: **12-inch asphalt dipped steel corrugated pipe through base of embankment with 24-inch pipe.**

The structure is in channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of **3.0 acre-feet**

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is **July 5, 1983**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 2, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.
