PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-66701 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to William H. Tucker of 24850 South Raney Lane, Estacada, Oregon 97023, phone 630-3989, for the construction of a reservoir, a tributary of Clear Creek and storage of water from an unnamed stream to be appropriated under Application 66702, Permit 47947 for recreation,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 4 South, Range 4 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

The maximum height will be 9.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 14.0 feet , slope of upstream face 2:1 , slope of downstream face 3:1 , and height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.5 acre , and the maximum depth of water will be 9.0 feet

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: 30 inch corregated metal pipe.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: 16-inch corregated metal pipe through the center of the dam.

The structure is in channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction with field boulder rip rap.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.0 acre-foot

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 22, 1983.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 20, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.
