## PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-67349 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to James and Grace Uri, TE-TA-MA Truth Foundation Family of Uri, Incorporated of PO Box 1147, Ashland, Oregon 97520, for the construction of Trinity Garden Reservoir 1 and 2, a tributary of Rogue River and storage of water from an Evergreen Spring Creek to be appropriated under Application 61870, Permit 47931 for beautification,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 17, Township 33 South, Range 2 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

The maximum height will be feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be slope of upstream face 1.5:1, slope of downstream face 1.5:1, and height of dam above water line when full 6 and 6 inches

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.5 acre , and the maximum depth of water will be 9.0 feet

- \* 3.4 feet and 1.8 feet
- \*\* I foot and 1.8 feet

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: Bottom widths are 2.0 and 2.2 feet, top widths are 2.0 feet and 2.6 feet, the distance between the crests of the dams and the crests of the spillways are 8 inches and 6 inches.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: Reservoir 1 - 6-inch concrete conduit with steel gate - 3.0 feet length - just to right of dam center; Reservoir 2 - 6-inch concrete conduit with steel gate - 6.0 feet length - just to right of dam center.

The structures is in channel.

The dams will be concrete construction. The dams are stone/mortar at stream channel, 12.0 feet wide with earthen embankment at ends to grade. The stream channel dam is concrete - 5.0 feet length with earthen embankment at end to grade.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.0487 acre-foot, being 0.0258 af in Reservoir 1 and 0.0229 af in Reservoir 2.

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is October 5, 1983

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 20, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.
