Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, OREGON BULB FARMS (Name of applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation Dec. 3, 1928 Oregon

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is not named

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Bear Creek tributary of Sandy River

3. The amount of water to be stored is .7 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 26, Tp. 1 S., R. 4 E., W. M., in the county of Clackamas (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Dam to be built across running stream. Earth dam with timber headgate.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4, Sec. 26, Tp. 1 S., R. 4 E., W. M. It will be 12 feet in height, (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

feet; width on top 12 feet slope of front or water side 2 1/2:1

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Earth dam with timber headgate - This is a small pool and no waves are anticipated.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Over dam through headgate eight feet wide and approximately 18" below top of dam.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: Outlet is 4" pipe directed into reservoir through which water is pumped

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be .12+ acres, with a maximum depth of water of 12 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 6 feet.
