PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-65612 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Charles L. Vaughn of PO Box 641, Winston, Oregon 97496, phone 679-5217, for the construction of Vaughn Reservoir, a tributary of Lookingglass Creek, and storage of water from an unnamed stream to be appropriated under Application 65613, Permit 48006 for irrigation,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20, Township 28 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

The maximum height will be 9.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.5 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 10.0 feet

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: None.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: Overflow is 4 inches pipe through dam flowline being 3.0 feet below crest of dam. Filling will be controlled to prevent overflow.

The structure is out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 3.0 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is August 25, 1983.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 6, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.
